#### BACKGROUND

P.A.C.E. (Canada) was founded in 1987 to assist community-based pre-schools in Jamaica in partnership with the Jamaica Ministry of Education. The focus has since expanded to include the well being of children in Canada and teacher education.

#### MISSION

P.A.C.E. promotes early childhood education with a special focus on children of pre-school age in situations of racial, cultural or economic disadvantage.

P.A.C.E. recognizes that the early years are crucial in the development and education of children. The organization therefore supports and mobilizes community efforts in ways that help to provide a positive learning environment for their young children.

This helps ensure that the children get the best possible start in life through sustainable nutrition, educational, and environmental programs. We feel this will reduce social and economic disparities, as well as provide the best opportunity for the children to compete in the global economy.

#### WHAT WE DO

#### ADOPT-A-SCHOOL PROGRAM

This program has been the cornerstone of the work of P.A.C.E. (Canada) since its inception. Through this program, P.A.C.E. supports annually more than 300 schools, thus investing in a brighter future for more than 12,000 little girls and boys aged 3 to 5 years. 3 to 5 years. There are over 2.600 schools. and approximately 130,000 children in the early childhood education sector. The need for support is huge.

#### How does the program work?

Here is what is involved:

A financial commitment of minimum of \$1 per day or \$365 per year for 3 years.

Every dollar donated to a school through P.A.C.E. (Canada)'s Adopt-A-School Program goes to the school.

 Tax receipts are provided for the amount donated.

Relationships between the schools and their sponsors are fostered through receipts, photographs and samples of the children's projects that the schools send through our organization for their sponsors.

#### Other Initiatives

School Supplies: Providing School Supplies is one of the ways in which P.A.C.E. (Canada) helps to enable Basic Schools / Early Childhood Institutions to provide an inspiring and enabling learning environment for children.

Children's Storybook Program: Each year, the Helen Sissons Canadian Children's Story Award is presented to a Canadian writer of stories for young children that reflect the diversity of the Canadian population.

Teacher Training & Development: We support early childhood student teachers in Canada and Jamaica through bursaries, and teacher certification in partnership with the HEART/National Training Agency in Jamaica. Conferences are also held to update the community on early childhood initiatives.

#### Support for Canadian Child Care Centres:

P.A.C.E. adopted Eastside Child Care Centre (in 2008) and East Scarborough Child Care Centre (in 2009). The Centres are administered by the Boys and Girls Club of East Scarborough. Annual donations are provided from our General Fund.

School Building Project: In 2011 a donation of \$108,500 (with \$50,000 from the Carpenters District Council of Ontario) laid the foundation for an early childhood institution building project at Sam Sharpe Teachers College in Jamaica. Ground breaking took place in April 2017.

Music & Movement: Sam Sharpe Teachers' College in Montego Bay is custodian of our full suite of musical instruments. Students in the College's Early Childhood Education program use the instruments as learning resources in their Music and Movement program, which is led by Dr. Vincent Conville.

Tech de Bus: In 2009, we donated a bus equipped with computers as a mobile lab, known as *Tech de Bus*. Allman Town Primary School in Kingston, is the custodian of Tech de Bus, for the benefit of students at that school and other schools in Kingston.

One Laptop per Child: Launched in 2011 in partnership with The Mona School of Business at the University of the West Indies, P.A.C.E. acquired 100 laptop computers as a pilot project. The initiative has demonstrated the ease with which young children utilize technology for learning and enjoyment.
