What is it?

"Brown Girl in the Ring" is a Caribbean children's game where kids sing and dance in a circle. It's popular in Jamaica and often played at school, parties, or in the yard. The game celebrates rhythm, confidence, and creativity, and it's easy to learn!

What You Need

- A group of children (minimum 5 is ideal)
- Open space for a circle (indoors or outdoors)
- Singing voices, or a speaker to play the song

How to Play - Step by Step

1. Form a Circle

- Children hold hands in a circle.
- One child is chosen to go into the centre of the circle.

2. Sing the Song

- Everyone sings together while gently moving around the circle.
- The child in the centre listens and gets ready to dance.

3. Dance in the Centre

- As the chorus repeats, the centre child dances, twirls, or moves however they like.
- During the "sugar in a plum" line, the child might show a special move, pose, or clap.

4. Repeat with Motions (Optional)

- Sing the second verse ("Show me your motion...")
- The centre child performs a motion, like clapping, spinning, or jumping.
- Everyone copies the motion while singing.

5. Switch Players

- When the song finishes or after a verse, the centre child chooses another child to take their place.
- The new child enters the centre and the game continues.

Helpful Tips

- Children of any gender can play just swap "girl" for "boy" or use their name.
- No special equipment needed just joy, music, and space!
- If children are shy, start by playing music and clapping until they feel comfortable.
- Always encourage creativity and fun over perfection.
